

ORDINANCE NO 3-2014

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CITY OF CORBIN, KENTUCKY
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 13-2013 RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGE CONTROL TO CHANGE CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS
RELATED TO SIGNS AND ADVERTISING OF ESTABLISHMENTS SELLING
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, WITHIN THE CITY OF CORBIN, KENTUCKY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF CORBIN, KENTUCKY AS
KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: Ordinance No. 13-2013 at SECTION 15, SIGNS AND ADVERTISING at Page 9 is
hereby amended and shall read as follows:

SECTION 15. SIGNS AND ADVERTISING

(A) All signage shall be in compliance with any and all other existing rules and
regulations of the City of Corbin and the City of Corbin Planning & Zoning Commission.

(B) No outside banners, posters or temporary signs displaying advertising which refers
either directly or indirectly to alcoholic beverage shall be displayed. ~~on nor shall it be visible from the
exterior of any premises licensed for the sale of alcoholic beverages, except that reference to such may
be included in the name of the business.~~

(C) This will not prevent interior illuminated non-flashing signs.

(D) All flashing signs are prohibited.

SECTION TWO: All ordinances and / or portions of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are
hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage and legal advertisement.
